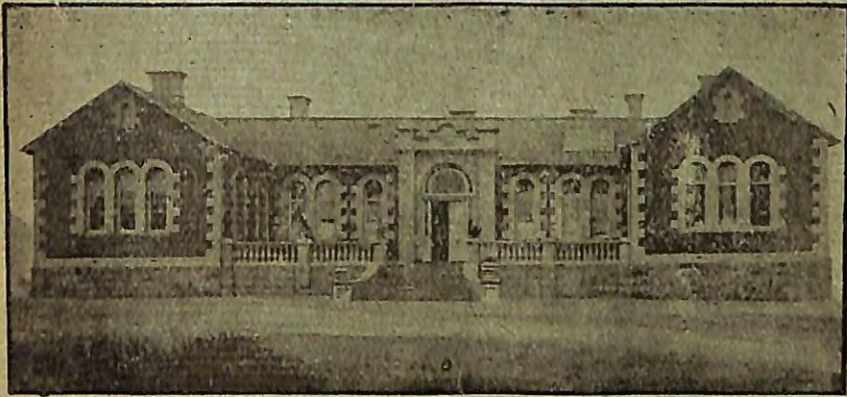

TO THE SUBSCRIBERS—

The Committee of Management of the Stawell Hospital have the honor to present to the Subscribers their Fifty-ninth Annual Report and Balance-sheet for the financial year ended 30th June. 1918.

Financial.

The Income from all sources for the year just ended amounts to £3564 15s, and the Expenditure to £2651 1s 10d. The Committee greatly appreciate the fact that, despite so many calls to Charitable and Patriotic Funds, the public have supported this Institution just as liberally as in past years. The following donations have been received during the year :—F. J. Cato Esq., £1000; G. T. Holden, Esq. (executor of the late G. Paganoni), £250; the late A. J. Graham's Estate, £50; the late J. Zerbst's Estate, £25; David Syme Charitable Fund, £25; Edmund Jowett Esq., M.H.R., £21; Trustees Sir W. A. Zeal's Estate, £5; Hall's Gap Progress Association, £2 2s; Edward Simmons (interest on War Loan), £45; Trustees Edward Wilson, £40; Felton Bequest, £30; Stawell Brass Band, £231; Landsborough Brass Band, £120 11s 9d; Since the year closed we have received £80 9s 6d from the late Mary Watson Estate; £25 from Messrs A. W. & G. A. Gray, Swinton; £35 from Stawell Borough Council; £17 12s in Private Contributions.

Obituary.

The Committee have to report, with deep regret, the death of their colleague, Mr. A. B. Clemes, who was a member of Committee from the foundation of the Hospital. The late Mr. Clemes took a great interest in everything pertaining to the Hospital's welfare. The Committee desire to place on record their appreciation of his services to the Institution. They also deplore the death of Capt. J. S. Trew, who was one of the auditors for some years.

Staff.

The Committee tender their thanks to Drs. J. R. Fox, W. J. Forshaw, and C. E. Jelbart, also the Nursing Staff, for the attention

paid by them to all cases. We are pleased to report that Dr. Forshaw has enlisted, and is now on Active Service.

Improvement to Buildings.

Since last Annual Report we have had the lavatories, as mentioned therein, erected at a cost of £836, they have already proved a good acquisition to the Hospital. We anticipate having verandahs erected on two sides of the building during the coming year, tenders having been invited, other improvements costing £85 15s 2d have also been carried out. In conclusion, the Committee offer their best thanks to all who have, by subscription, donation, or other means assisted the funds of the Hospital, and wish to specially mention the members of the Stawell and Landsborough Brass Bands, also to all gentlemen who placed their motor cars at the disposal of the Committee to convey the Bandsmen to the various centres. The Committee hope that the kindly charity which prompted the support given in the past may lead to renewed effort on behalf of this deserving Institution.
