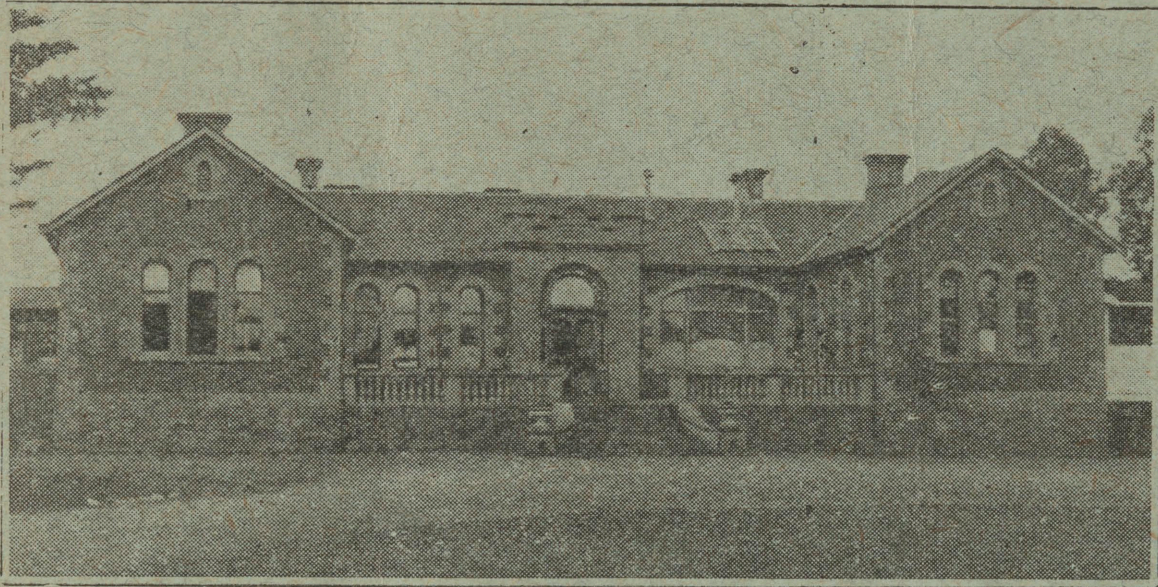

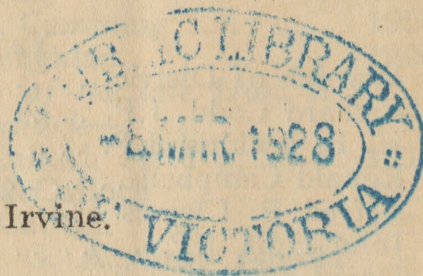

To the Subscribers.—

The Committee of Management of the Stawell and District Hospital have the honor to submit to the Subscribers the sixty-eighth Annual Report and Balance Sheet for the financial year ended June 30th, 1927. The Receipts from all sources amounted to £3,540/12/1 and expenditure £3,240/15/1, reducing the overdraft at the Union Bank to £95/11/7 at the end of the financial year.

The Committee desires to express its appreciation of the liberal support given by the public to the appeals made on behalf of the Hospital throughout the year. In doing so the Committee wish to make special mention of the excellent result achieved by the Hospital Bed Appeal organised by Mr O'Connor. Nineteen Schools, seven Organisations and seven individuals have placed beds in the Hospital.

It is pleasing to report that the amount contributed by the Stawell Brass Band Hospital Sunday Appeal was £292/19/1.

Much praise is due to the Ladies' Sewing Committee for work done throughout the year.

The Government Grant has been increased to £580, and after representation was made to the Stawell Shire and Stawell Borough Councils, their grants were generously increased.

During the year 435 In-patients and 81 Out-patients were treated at the Hospital.

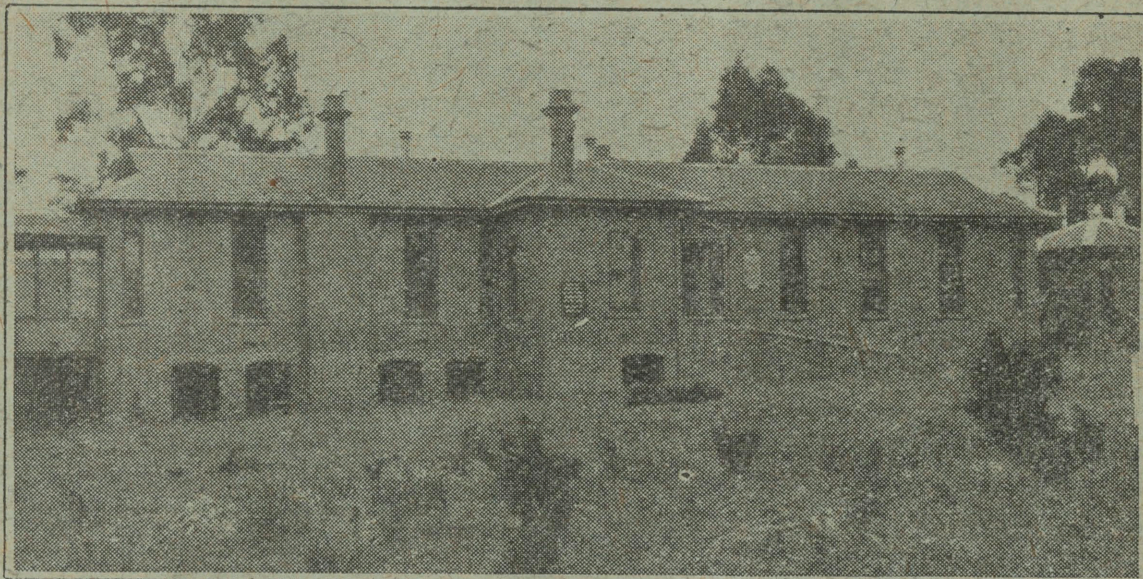
